Wednesday

Very stormy day mostly sunny, frosty, snowing and blowing. Willie and I each took a heifer (Ducine and Friday sold to Wm Shortreed on Monday) over to his place in A.M. In P.M. Arthur Perry and J. Michie came with span and took two fords Sam M.: Lee & Clark and us up to Cumwells to vote. Gibson and Craig candidates for M.P.P. mother up in P.M. Willie drover down. Paid Dandrem 7.25

Very frosty day, sunny. Bob & Taylor came up for ot's grey calf sold to Wm Shortreed on 23rd. Willie drove May down town in P.M. she got at Steels flannel and spools 41 covered Ammets 20 also stove blacking 10 rice 25 gave me it 15 eggs 27cts sold butter to Mrs M. Vicars 2-28 gave butter to Annual meeting 57cts. I went to Annual meeting in dwell at night.
