Dundee water Raising some
one of the cows cast her
calf Rocket into Lancaster
a Meeting in Dundee to night
Cairron and Stephens speaking
6th Fine Day sea and Fernandez
came Bought Wash-Basin 2 Bushels
calico and other stuff
Sowed Wheat Forest sowing
Ploughing Taking up Stones
Sadore here wanting Mary
more chickens out 7th Fine
Orlov Day Taking Stone off
of the Wheat ground Sowed
the 4 Bushels of Wheat
one of the cows calved
the nannie lost her 2 Lambs
very Unwell to night
what churning

Wheat ground sowed some of
Barley at the Lower Point
Taking Stones of the Lower Point
Fine Gordon came not
very well 10th Fine Fernandez
went to Lancaster Got 2 Calves
from A. Fraser Brought
of the Small Pigs to him
Ploughing and Taking Stones
11th Very Fine Sowed 5 Bushels
Oats Taking off Stones Fernandez
went to Dundee took a
ballot Election in Dundee
12th Day Ploughing some of the
Potato ground Sewell went
Round Island to Plough
found a narrow tooth that I never
found and there is 1 lost at the
wet place east of the House
cleaning up stairs to Day
Stephens Got in 12th Fine
Foggy Rained Sowed 3 Bushels
Oats Taking off Stones Hamilton
went Down
