- 8 Very fine day Uncle Donald sent us two little black pigs 6 week old, yesterday. Angus M. Tellum. J. B. was buried today. He died after 2 hours illness Monday 1. A.M. To 1/2 gall molasses 25 1 lb currants 9 - 9 yds gray cotton 4 cts. 36. Pa was fixing fence on 2d Con farm 34 36
- 9 Fine, true was digging over garden Sarah M. Donald, South Branch (Chealey) was buried today. Pa paid the acc. at M. Cummings, sugar put out fish out meal To 3 bunches butter 24, silk thread 14 1.47 38
- 10 Muddy & Pa put up the porch, and gave a coat of paint. Muddy & J. G. went to Apple Hill. It is very cold
- 11 Fine bright day, turned cold in afternoon and began to snow about 2.30 P.M. Pa went for the helpers, could not drive them they are wild. To 1 lb tea 25 - 2.14 butter 72. 97

- 12 Sunday Fine and bright, the ground is covered by snow. No service in our church Bird & Muddy went to Hezekiah
- 13 Fine day. Fixed the pig pen, set a leach
- 14 Another fine day. Muddy went North early To 2 lbs sausage 20 cts 1 pt of M. Cummings p. hog 20 46 lbs at 4 cts 182. Got some logs sawn yesterday Lavallette drew the lumber today. Charged 1.00 for four loads, Stewart Ferguson took 6 bush of wheat to Martintown and got it ground for us. Charged 50 25
- 15 Fine day. gave Alick Strop 25. By little Joe, for 3 hours work at the saw mill
- 16 I was working up stairs, Muddy cleaned the furnace pipes. Jimmie Brown & James Clark. Jimmie come about 3 P.M. Starting since Tuesday 25
- 17 To 3 lbs steak 30. 4 lb sugar 25 53
- 18 Fine day Thawing. There was a boy drowned in Martintown last evening. Starting To 4 1/2 lb sugar 25. 2 lb raisins 20. 1/4 Cream tartar 1 lb butter 23, 2 spools silk thread 23 Muddy got home the helpers on Wednesday the 16th The war in the Transvaal is not progressing so favorably as the British would desire 25
- 19 Fine day. some people plowing in, Uncle Donald was saying. To 3 lbs butter 23 69 4 1/2 sugar 25 25
- 20 Sunday Very fine day. James Clark left for home. Birdie went with Apple Hill Rev. M. Lord preached a Union sermon in afternoon in St. Andrew's on the centenary fund Collected 5 5
- 21 Mild day. Pa no worse. Making a small pot of soap. To 1 gall coal oil 20. oat meal 25, salts 5 50
