August 1 Ad & the Men worked at the oats in the old pear  
field & cut some in the middle field I went  
with Samuel Moonhead to his father's & others  
to see if they would sign the call for Mr. Nicholson  
<sup>they all did</sup>

2 Sam. Moonhead & went to Fairfax with the call all  
signed the call to Wallace & the Men worked  
at the grain very warm day

3 they got all the oats cut at the road then they  
cut in North field Wallace & I drew in 2 loads  
of the <sup>up</sup> middle field I raked this morning

4 Ad & Wallace worked at the road drawing  
in grain fine day Mr. Nicholson came on Ex-  
press Rev. Mr. Brown this morning Mr. Nicholson at night

6 Ad & Wallace cut their wheat at the road in  
the forenoon cut part of ours in the afternoon

7 finished getting wheat & oats near they had  
<sup>and drew 1 load of oats want full</sup>  
Bruce's Reaper fine shade this afternoon

8 Ad & Wallace hoaked the peas in the front  
field I went to Mr. Finkers Garding's & Reber-  
son with the call they all signed it

9 Ad & Wallace drew in the peas wheat and  
the Norway oats of the front field I turned  
over the peas and spread out the oats all the  
grain is in ~~seed~~ except the peas in the North  
field they are not fit to cut yet

10 George & Bessie went to spring with the buggy for  
Lennie Ad helped Bruce & Mel

11 George & Bessie got home in the forenoon Lennie  
Mary & Mrs. Tongue came with them fine shade  
of rain at noon Mr. Nicholson came on Express

12 Rev. Mr. Brown preached in the morning Mr. Nicholson  
<sup>at night</sup>

13 Ad & George helped Bruce I fixed the bolster  
of the truck wagon Mrs. Tongue went home on  
the Mixed Billie took Mary home

14 Ad helped Bruce I met the Rev. Mr. Smith  
at the station held a meeting to sustain the call  
to Mr. Nicholson it was unanimous he went back on  
<sup>the mixed</sup>

15 Ad Bruce & Mr. Kelver hoaked peas this fore-  
noon & Mr. Kelver forked them this afternoon
