- 18 Bellmore put in four loads of hay in our barn, Doest put in one
- 19 John Mc Lennan called to bid us good by, he is leaving tomorrow for Lancaster Pa gave him a little loaf of sugar 35cts  
7/8 bread 48, foul oil 20, two keys for fiddle 88  
I boiled 4 lb goose berries, 3 lbs red currant jelly, 7/8 2 lbs ramage tick 20cts
- 20 Had Ann Hall 1/2 day 25cts. Far was down for about 3 hours, Katis colt died kind of sudden, Jimmie had Mums to see it, he could not tell what was wrong with it. Doest put in two loads of hay Mundy came at 9 P.M. Bellmore has in three loads more
- 21 Fine cool day Doest another load
- 22 Boiled about 8 lb currants, 7/8 lb sugar 1.15  
7/8 3 lbs ramage 30, Paid 60 for last week 90  
7/8 pan bread 24 Miss Litch spent a few hours with us and took tea, she is visiting at Mr Longalds, Mrs Rogers (Maggie Falkner), called, Bellmore one load
- 23 Fine day, a pretty large congregation
- 24 Fine so far 7.30 Mundy has left for Cornwall
- 25 7/8 3 loaves
- 26 ~~and~~ and I went to Donald Roy's old place and to Calder's. drove George, 7/8 3 lb ramage 30
- 27 Fine day, corners of showers, Doest put in loads of hay 5 loads put in at Bellmore
- 28 Fine day, I went in afternoon to call at D. Falkner, and after tea went call at F. Robertson's, Marion and Clara Kennedy came for me about 9 P.M.
- 29 Marion & Clara left about 5.15 P.M. to take the boat at Lancaster for Valley field, 7/8 4 loaves at Dunlops 24 tick  
7/8 5 lbs stew 30cts

- 29 Jimmie was at Alexandria yesterday. Far from the Cove came and told that our 2 year mare got hurt. Jimmie for her today, and Katy got an ugly cut over her right eye. So there are two to be working at, he had Mums to see them  
Donald M. Cummins had a party on Thursday night all our folk were there
- 30 It began to rain some time last night and now 9 P.M. is still raining. There were but a few in church. Alick Scot preached
- 31 Rain all last night and all day until now. 2 P.M. Got word from Marion, she will not be back until Wednesday. Mrs Pidgeon paid \$6.00 for rent

On August 7th I sold 24 day eggs for 16.56  
at 10c per doz. Got 7/8 lb Cream tartar 20 1/4  
lb pepper 10. Salt 5 - 1/4 shive of linc  
10 / cream 5 - fly paper 5 = 20
