

# Charles "Wesley" Tofflemire (1868-1961)

## 1903-1907

Transcribed by Rural Diary Archive volunteers

DISCLAIMER: This diary depicts some discriminatory content which some may find offensive. During the diary's time period, such racial terms and prejudices were commonplace in Canadian society. They are considered wrong today.

March th/28 {SL/354 in pencil in different hand} 1903

(28) Went down to Filips and got my old pig and pruned apple trees a fine day

(29) Sunday a cold north wind we went up to church and to Dady toffs

(30) Went to kings town with a load of wood Dady snider and mother were down and i order for a Binder an mower and a rake

(31) Cut fence poasts and halled peaces of rails it was a fine day for the last of March

(1) April the first planted fence poasts a long the road and fixed the hogpen and cut apple trees Alice went to Oxley and Grace to Kingsville 526

2 April th/2 1903

(2) Drine {drain} watter furrows and Did the chors and went up to Mister Wrights it rained in the morning but a fine after noon

(3) A north east sow storm i put away the cutter and worked in the shop Sowd old sod oats on the second of April

(4) I did the chores and worked in the shop and piled up what i did yester the snow is a about gon

(5) Went up to the baptest in the morning and stoped at John Arners for diners and went to kings town in the evening

3 April 6th 1903

(6) I helped wash and open some furrows in the forenoon and filed Roscoes buck saw and pruned trees in the after noon it is raining to night

(7) We pruned trees and burnt the brush the mud was so sticky i thought i would loose my boots

(8) I went out and helped plant the apple trees and peach trees and helped put the wire on the road fence

(9) We finished the fence and put in the tile and Gordia and Roscoe went fishing

(10) We cut wood in the orchard and maid a hog trough and went back to the orchard and dug a ditch and helped John load oats that is all

April th/11 1903 (11)

I did the chores and split wood in the forenoon and in the afternoon I filed John Arners saw and plaid with the pup and Alice a wet rain.

(12) Went up to Daddy Sniders and to church it rained hard and heavy my speller is not right as youl. notes.

(13) I took a load of oats up for John and it rained all the way home and its raining yet I got some potatoes from John for seed white jient {White Giant} and church hill {Churchill} seedling and early rose

(14) I cleaned the seller and did the choers it rained all day and still rains Bob has left us. my old pig found me nine pigs to day = April the " 14th

5 April th/15 1903

(15) I took John arners scales home and Rube Arners corn sheller home and maid a gait I went down to Roscoes in the after noon and put afloor in the pig nest it rained to day

(16) We went down town through the rain in the morning in the afternoon I baged up some oats and went to the bush and skided some bolts out to the road afine afternoon

(17) I went out to the mill with chop and took my bolts out in the morning in the after noon I put the rize bords on the henhouse and helped Lues with the calvs a fine day

(18) I did the chores and split wood in the morning and I went to town after diner another fine day. Roscoe went up hone fore the night

April th/19 1903

(19) A fine sunday. Bob and I went to the lake and chased a bumble bea. we went up to Church it was a fine day

(20) I helped Alice wash in the morning and maid some hen nests and after diner I went out to the orcherd and harrowed the stubels and acame back a fine day agin

(21) I helped Mister Loot moove his house and Roscoe halled golddust and plowed for oats.

(22) I went and got pinch Bidy was sick this morning I plowed in the afternoon it snowed last night

23 We plowed for oats out back and Roscoe went to town and I went to Sladons and cleaned oats for seed it was a fine day.

7

April th/24 1903

(24) We put in our first oats to day it was fine in the forenoon but it rained all afternoon and still rains

(25) We went to the bush and cut posts to fix the road brige and I went out to mill and helped with the brige a fine day.

(26) We went up to church and when we got home Will and Lerina was hear it was a fine day sunday

(27) We plowed and soad oats hear in the field by the lake a fine day I am so tired my feet wont track to night o dear

(28) We finished the field hear by the lake we got it sowed and the furows cleaned and we finished the brige at the road Roscoe got a pig from me to night it waid 74 pounds  
{mathematical calculation:  $74 \times 5 = \$3.70$ }

Aprile th/29 1903

(28)We went out in the eight acer field and plowed and soad oats it was a fine day I turned the cows out

(30) We plowed and soad oats in the morning in the afternoon it rained Roscoe maid a hog trough I think it will freeze to night

May May th/1 1903

(1) We plowed and soad oats Dady syneder was down it was so cold I had to ware my over coat and mits

(2) We finished sowing oats and put in some potatos and Roscoe went to town Botsward got some hay and John brought his old hog hear

(3) We went up to Oxley to church there was a cold west wend and some rain misses Eldia Hares is very sick to day Lambert has left Oxley

9 May th/4 1903

(4) We plowed for corn out in the hany field for the first it was a fine day Alise went up to dadys for pinch and a horse

(5) We plowed for corn out in the hany field it was a hot day, Robert Mackmany got some hay

(6) We finished plowing the hany field for corn Lambert cane down and got some oats and the hors we had

(7) We roled disked in the hany fild I sent Alices jim to harrow and got ten dollers for him poor jim

(8) We dished in the fourmon and went to the furniel of misses Ernest Iler it was a sad furniel and a big one

(9) We dished in the morning in the afternoon we halled hay one tun to Botsward

10

May th/10 1903

(10) We went up to Dady Syders and to church. Mister Milcon preached it was a fine day it lookes like rain to night.

(11) We plowed and disked in the morning and went to Oxley in the afternoon with hay for Missis Brown.

(12) I soed grass seed in the morning and went to the bush and roscoe disked in the afternoon. I plowed two rounds and drawed four loads of manure and we hilled a pig.

(13) We halled goldust. doll found a colt last night th/12 1903 Ellive sent a load of lumber up to day.

(14) We drawed gold dust it was fire day. Roscoe went to town to night.

(15) We drawed golddast. Mary Brat was down and staid all night.

11

May th/16 1903

(16) We drawed goldsdust and I went out to the mill and got my pickets and chop. Alice took Mary down to Kingsville.

(17) We went up to C.N. Tofflemires and to Church and pinch came home with us.

(18) Roscoe harowed and I shelled corn. Dady Snider brought his heifer down th/17 of May 1903.

(19) I got P.C. to plant a field of corn. It was a hot day. I did a little of every thing and not much of eny thing and finished up hear.

(20) We worked on the corn ground it is hard and dry. Alice tuck pinch home.

(21) We worked on the corn ground it is so hot we cant do much we put to the time bay chiming clods and sods.

12 May th/22 1903

22 Rosco plowed and I scatered golddust We had a fine rain

(23) Rosco finished plowing the eight acre field for corn it looks a lot like rain to night I helped Harry plant corn

24 Sunday We went up to church in the afternoon

(25) We disked all day I went up and got Botswards planter for to morow—

(26) We disked and harowed and planted corn Solom Iler and R Baker was here to day Dady tuf came after the root drill

May th/27 We planted corn and I roald oats in the morning we plowed and scatered golddust we had a big wind and rain it blew down fense and a lot of tres

13 May 28th 1903

(28) We piled up what the wind did in the morning and Rosco plowed in the after noon

(29) I helped with the lain fence it blew down and spread gold dust Bub and Harry helped me with it Roscoe plowed and planted

30 I spread golddust Roscoe plowed and planted corn and Gordia plowed and harrowed We went up to Dady snyders for dinner and went out to church

31 We went up to Dady snyders for dinner and went out to church

June the first 1903

(1)I replanted corn in the hany field and Roscoe plowed it rained after dinner

(2) We took the ~~railes~~ trees out of Rubs field Roscoe plowed after noon

16 June the/3 1903

3 We finished planting corn to day and aint I glad

4 I roled and Roscoe did a little of every thing and not much of anything and Ruben Arner roled one field to day for me

5 We plowed the little orchard and put in sum potatoes and I plowed my beet patch and went to the corner

6 I planted my beets we had a fine rain. Bidy went up home

7 We went down to stadons for diner then out to church at Caleforna

8 I cut posts for the line fence Rub helped me I plowed corn for the first

9 I plowed corn between showers and a number of other things

June th/10 1903

10 I went to town with a load of oats and got my moer and rake and did a number of other things too numers to mention

11 I harrowed corn and plowed corn I thought I would freeze old doll has a lump on her sholder as big as a bag of oats

12 I helped with the line fence all day near west of the bildings

13 I did a little of every thing and aint much of anything for it rained all day

14 Sunday We went up to Dady T's for dinner and up to Church

15 I went up to dady Sniders and got a calf and plowed corn in the afternoon. doll felt bad to day June the 15 — 1903

16 June th/16 1903

(16) I plowed corn all day for the first time this season it sounds like rain to night. they came and set up my mower and rake to day.

(17) I plowed corn and odear it is planted so crucked that I I.I.I.I.I don't no - - - - -

(18) I plowed corn between showers and did the chores and have fine growing wether the oats and grass is fine. Roscoe finished planting tobacco to day the/18 1903 think of me

(19) I plowed corn and it rained we put up some chop and did the chores.

(20) I did the chors and it rained all day I went to the corner and up to Squires to see his pigs.

(21) We went up to church in the morning and up to Oxley in the after noon.

17 June th/22 1903

(22) I went out to mill in the morning and plowed corn and it rained the rest of the day and still rains.

(23) We got some bolts and put the gat at the road.

24 We fixed at the fence north of the barn and I went and got my chop and took some bolts out to the mill and Roscoe went to Town Botsward paid for the oats and hay.

(25) I plowed corn. It was a fine day. Bidy went calling and Rose came home with her.

(26) We plowed corn all day. It was hot and dry.

(27) I went to town with a load of oats and got my binder and plowed corn.

14 June th/24 1903

24 We went up to church it was a fine day

29 We plowed corn to day and Gordia cut his grass to day

30 I plowed corn and halled gravel and odear it was so hot 1

July th/1 1903 We put Gordies hay in it was a hot day he had seven loads of fine hay

2 I cut grass in the morning and in the after noon i put the hay fork up and cut thistles

(3) We halled hay to day for the first I cut thistels in the morning and kicked up the hay and we had a fine rain this evening

19 July th/4 1903

4 I went up to dady squiers and plowed corn and cut grass and it is raning tonight

(5) We went up to Dady Sniders for dinner and out to church the scool gave Roxee afine presant to day

(6) I cut grass and kicked up the hay and We got one load in before noon and We halled 4 in the after noon

7 We finished the hay to day and I am glad it lookes like rain to night

8 I plowed corn and howed beets i gess that is all for this time so good night

9 I hoed beets and cut grass for Rube I cut grass after diner and it was drienough to hall to night. hot.

20 July the/10 1903

10 I cut grass for Rube and cut the weeds along the road and helped put the binder up and went to bed and

11 We howed beets and I went up to Dady Squiers and got my red pig and we fixed the fence along the west lain Gordia and Pinch was down to night

12 I plowed corn it rained Gordia cut wheat and Roscoe helped him

13 I plowed corn and took the lumber to the bush for the shanty Edie Scratch was up to day

14 I went and cut Humprys wheat and eight others for it

15 I plowed corn and we are a going to Oxley to night I got my hat on ready to go so good by

21 July the/16 1903

16 I plowed corn in the morning and we helped Gordia draw his wheat to day

17 Bidy and I went to Harrow in the after noon we had a big rain last night the wind blew the oats and corn down

18 We plaid in the forenoon and went up to Oxley to church in the afternoon

20 I hoed in the garden and went to town it rained all afternoon

21 I put the rake away and took the rack of the wagon and made a single tree and went down to Roscoes and did some work in the barn and went over to Rubs and went and got the horses ready for morning and I guess that is all

22 We went and got my logs cut Toms and Dads were down to day

22 July the/23 1903

(23) We went down to Kingsville and got some lumber and thinned beets and Bidy went up to see Grany

(24) I plowed corn and went out to the mill with chop Jacon was down to day I would like to get up before breakfast in the morning

(25) I took six hogs to harrow to day they weighed 13.77 pounds I got \$68.85 for them and I plowed some corn Tne and shut a old pig to fat

(26) We went up to church and the people did not know me guess because I cut my mistash of

(27) We plowed corn we finished one field and started a nother

(28) We plowed corn it was hot to day

23 July the/29 1903

(29) I plowed corn and plowed beets it was a hot day

(30) I went out and got many pickets and made pign pen floors and a chicken cup

(31) I hoed potatos in the morning and dug ditch along the lane this after noon

August the/1 I finished the ditch along the lane and planted my selery and plowed corn

(2) We went up to Toms and to church

(3) I helped wash and filed the saw and Dady and Mother Snider was down

(4) I did the choers and went up to J. Arners and bought threee pigs and went to the corner

24 August the/5 1903

Wind

5 We fixed take fence along the patch north of the house and I went out to the corned and got my boy to night

6 I cut humpys oats today and started mine

7 I cut oats in the fore noon and after dinner. We finished the fence north of the house

8 We plowed corn all day in the big field and bidy and Jim went to town

10 We cut oats it was a fine day but it is thundering to night

11 We finished cutting oats and I went to finish humpys I got it half done

12 I finished humpys oats and put the binder away and we plowed corn

25 August 1903 the/13

13 We halled oats today it was a fine day and bidy and jim and I went up to dadys to night

14 We plowed corn and helped Gordia hall oats it was a fine day

15 We drawed oats all day and got done bidy and grace went to town its trying to rain to night

16 We went up to Dady Sniders for dinner and to church it was a fine day.

17 I went to Harrow and Roscoe plowed corn

18 We shelled corn and halled oats for Gordia it was a hot day.

19 I went to Lueses bea it rained all after noon it was a fine rain just what we wanted.

26 August the/20 1903

20 I went to town with chop. It was a fine day. I started to plow for wheat.

21 We plowed all day. We got along fine better than I expected.

22 We plowed all day. It was hot and dry and hard and the flies is so bad and the bumblebeas are worse and odear me I I I I

23 We went up to church. It was a fine day. Rev. Mister Long preached.

24 We cut some posts for some new fence out the lawn and I put one in. It is so wet I cant plow for wheat.

25 I plowed a little and rolled a little and had the summer complante a little and we went up to Edie llers a little while to night.

27 August 26, 1903

26 We disked in the morning and drawed gold dust in the afternoon.

27 We drawed two loads of menuer and it rained the rest of the day.

28 I did the chores. It rained all day and is raining yet the watter is standing every place.

29 I went to town this morning and got wier for the lain fence and did chores this after noon.

30 We went up to Dady Sniders for dinner and we went out to church.

31 We went up to Dady Tufflemiers and helped thrash to day.

28 September the/1 1903

1 I trimed the trees out in the long field and plowed a little

2 I drawed golddust and plaid with dady and took my hogs down town and got \$78.73 c for then I had six of them

3 I worked on the shanty in the bush to day it was a fine day

4 We drawed goldust all day it was a fine day but still wet and looks wetter to night

5 We finished halling menuer to day it was a fine day Roscoe went to town to night

7 I dug hotatoes in the garden and fixed the bins is the granery and spread manuer and plowed a little

29 September the/8 1903

8 I drew two loads of ashes out back and plowed some it was hot to hay

9 I thrashed to day I had 710 bushels of oats and I helped bub thrash too

10 I went to the bea at mister botswards it was the worst mes ever sen the oats was rotten.  
The toad stools was all over the top of the mow

11 I went to the bea I will bee glad wen I am home again

13 I plowed all day it was a hot day Antie Huldys was hear to day

14 I plowed and roled it was a hot day

Bidy is sck to night

15 We worked on the wheat ground this forenoon it rained all after noon and still rains

30 September the/17 1903

17 it rained and rained and I put the stove up and cleaned Humpys timothy seed and took  
pinch home Jaspers Baby is deed

18 We dug potatoes in the fournoon and went to the funerl of Jaspers Baby

19 We dug potatos it was mier dig thar potatoes

21 I plowed a little and disked a little I would like to get my wheat in this fall I missed it this  
summer

22 I disked and got my seed wheat it looks like rain to night

23 I driled wheat today it went in fine Roscoe went to the bees

24 I disked and drilled in wheat it was a fine day but it was cold this morning

31 September th/25 1903

25 I finished drilling and cleaned the barn and went out back and plowed and got a load of  
wood

26 I finished plowing for wheat today and helped Roscoe hang tobacco Grany died last night  
God bless her

28 I roled in the morning and cut seed clover this afternoon

29 We cut corn all day it was a fine day for cutting

30 We cut corn it was a fine day it looks like rain to night we went to finish cutting our field  
tomorrow

32 October the/1 1903

1 We cut corn betwen shewers. Bidy went to Town and stoped at Stadons and got  
something to eat and brought some peaches home.

2 We finished the hany field and started the other it was a fine day my corn is good in the  
eight acre field.

3 We cut corn all day. It was a fine day for cutting if the frost stays long enough we will get  
dun

5 We finished cutting another field of corn and o I am glad.

6 We finished the wheat today and got some nuts. Roscoe cut corn in the big field today.

7 We cut corn and went to the fair at Harrow it rained all the way home.

33 October the/8 1903

8 We went and got a load of nuts and cut corn it rained it is offel wet in the field the clay  
pulses off my boots.

9 We cut corn today but o deer the mud is so sticky it pulls my boots off.

10 We cut corn. It is pitty culle tonight I look for frost tonight.

12 We cut corn today. It was wet this morning we did not do much.

13 We finished cutting corn today and planted posts out the lain and killed a pig to night.

14 We finished the fence out the lain and roake the clover up.

15 We went up to dadys Tufflemires and got some corn and put in a gait out the lain and put in the sweep acrost the road.

34 October 16/th 1903

(16) We husked corn to day for the first it is tuff yet

(17)I went to town with chop this morning and drawed corn this afternoon

(18)We husked corn to day it was a fine day I found ice Sundy morning in the trough

(20)We husked corn in the morning and picked apples this afternoon it was a fine day dady and Mother was down

(21)We husked corn again it was a fine day Bidy went home to day she got waid she waid away up in a 103 pounds

(22) We husked corn to day it got dry this after noon

35 October the/23 1903

(23) We husked corn it was a cold day it snowed a little and blowed a lot

(24) We husked corn in the morning and maid a brige bye the corn louse and maid a wagon box and went to town

(26) We husked corn and pulled roots this after noon

(27) We husked corn and finished the beets its a lot warmer to night

(28) We drawed corn to day it was a fine day we have one field husked

(29) We drawed corn all day it was a nother fine day

(30) We husked corn it was a fine day Bidy went up to Dadys and took pinoh home

36 October the/31 1903

31 We halled fodder Gordia came down and helped me today

November November the/2 1903

2 We holled fodder and husked corn it was a fine day.

3 We husked and halled corn it was a fine day ~~~~~~

4 We husked and drewed corn another fine day ~~~~~~

5 I went to harrow in the morning and we husked corn this after noon and put the potatoes and apples in the seler ~~~~~~

6 it snowed and it blowed all morning and we husked corn this afternoon.

7 We hished corn and halled corn we finished the seckend field.

37 November the/9 1903

9 We husked corn in the big field for the first it was a fine day.

10 We husked corn and mooved tonight. I fit some pipe together and a o My l.l.l.l thought I

11 We drewed corn and husked corn and it rained this afternoon.

12 We went to the bush and got yung eicher and did chores and husked corn.

13 I helped Lewes kill pigs and husked corn.

14 We husked corn and drewed corn.

16 I put shelves in the pantry and did a lot of other things it was a rainy day.

38 November the/17 1903

17 We husked corn and did chores it is trying to snow to night

4 We took a loed of fodder to the boosh and did choers

19 We drewed a load of corn and fenced the strawstack and I made a storm doar

20 We drewed some fodder and husked some corn

21 We drewed corn and husked corn

23 It rained some to day and looks like it will rain more to night I washed and Samie husked corn to day

24 I butchered my hogs and Staddon and Botsward and Cull killed three and I drewed a load of corn

39 November the/25 1903

25 I halled clover to day and helped Ruden Arner hall some

26 I broke stubls and took fodder to the bus and went to the bea and got my eyes full of dirt

27 We drewed corn and went to the bush and got a load of wood and finished husking corn to day the/27

28 We bilt fence and brought moly and her calf in from the bush

30 I helped bidy wash and we went down to Staddons

40 December the/1 1903

1 I potterd around all day this founnon and we went out to crner this afternon.

2 I halled wood all day on the log boat it was a fine day Bidy went to harrow to day.

3 We drewed foder it was a fine day Dady snider was down and Mister dowles.

4 We finished halling foder to days it was a fine day. Ruden Arner helped me this after noon.

5 I took a load of foder down to Staddon and bought the cattle in and went to town and paid my rent and taxes.

7 I helped wash and did chores the rest of the day.

41 December the/8 1903

8 I poterd around all day and split word and took Hunpys shain home its trying to snow to night.

9 I did the chores and fixed the stable and put the colt in and split wood this afternoon, Biddy went to lexies and to Oxley.

10 I split wood and did the chores it was a fine day I think I will go to bed now so good night for this time.

11 I did the chores and worked in the shop it was a cold day.

12 I went to the corner and shelled corn and worked in the shop it rained all day.

14 I went to the bees it was a cold day. porks six a hundred. {six cents a hundred weight}

42 December the/15 1903

15 I shelled corn for chop and did chores all day it is still cold this fier {fire} hear is as contrary as a pig on ice I got ~~more~~ more smoke in the room heat.

16 Biddy and I went up to Daby sniders and I went to harrow it was a fine day.

17 I put a bunk on the wagon and painted it and Biddy went down to Roscoes to see the Babys.

18 I maid a mall and put the wagon together and did the chores and loaded up some corn for chop I would like to get up before breakfast so good night.

19 I took ~~ym~~ my chop to mill to day and it rained all after noon.

21 I maid a reach for the wagon and put a handle in the mall and got a hog of John Arner.

43 December the/16 1903

22 I went and got my team shawed and got my chop it is good slaying now.

23 We drewed lims from the bush and went to the Christmas tree up hear.

24 We went up to the Christmas tree it rained all day.

25 We did the chores and got one load of wood it was a fine Christmas day it is trying to snow to night.

26 I filled chimney up and went up to see dady he is sick he workes too hard it is cold to night the chimney got a fier to night.

28 I helped wash this morning and did the choers we went to the bush and got a load of limbs.

December the/29 1903

29 I maid a pæir storm door and slay for Jim wehad a big snow storm last night we will have slaying it doant blow off the roads.

30 I cut a little wood and did the chores it was a fine day old jirsy {Jersey} found a calf to day the pig pen is about full of snow to night

31 I cut a little wood and did the chores. Toms were down to day in the slay.

so good by old year good by god bless thoes days gon by C.W. Lofflemire Arner Ont

December the/31 1903

A hapy new year {encircled with curly doodlings} == January the/1 1904 ==

1 We cut enough wood to help warm and did the choers. Edgure was down to day

2 It was a stormey day it snowed all day I put the slays to gether and got the cutter down.

4 I went to town to day with some wood it was a cold day it was ten below zerow

5 We cut logs to day it is still cold but I think it will chang soon

6 We cut logs and I drewed one it snowed all fore noon I think it will rain to night so good night huny good night -----

(7) I drewed logs it was a fine day it looks like rain to night Bidy went to town to day in the cutter it is good slaying now -----

Jenuary the/4 1904

8 I drewed logs it was soft to day it rained a little and snowed a little Bidy went to Oxley and out home.

9 We drew logs to day it was afine winter day I think I can finish in a nother day if it is fine  
Bidy scrubed and scoured things up to day till they shine like a negro's heal.

10 11 I helped wash and went to see Dady he is no better it was afine day the best winter  
wether I ever saw I think.

11 12 I drewed some logs it snowed the afternoon and is snowing yet.

12 13 We went up to dadys Sniders and back to dady Tuffs and home again it was a fine  
day.

14 I drewed one load of logs and filed the saw it snowed all day.

January the/15 1904

15 I drewed logs in the morning and went to kingsville this afternoon the slaying it fine I  
never seen better.

16 We shelled some corn and cut some wood and did choers it in a bit colder to night. I  
think, the lain will be fool in the morning for the snow is fling high.

18 I sold too calvs for \$13\$ it was a cold day I maid a platform for the stoar and filed my  
saw so good night I want to go to bed.

19 I did the choers and sit by the fier it was a cold morning but it rained this eving we went  
up to Dadys he is looking better I think

20 it rained all day and is raining yet. I took it eazy and watched it rain the slaying is bought  
gon in spots ~~~~~~

January the/21 1904

21 It rained all day and is raining yet. I worked in the shop a little. the watter is up to the pigs  
ears.

22 it rained all day and I sit and looked at it it is snowing to night I orderd my binder twine  
at 12 cents 100 pounds \$12

23 It snowed all day this forenoon we put a floore in the cow stable and I went to town it is a cold night to night.

25 I helped wash and did chores it is still cold I filed my saw a gain it is ~~snowy~~ snowing again

26 We shelled some corn and cut some wood it snowed all day from the north east the snow is up to the top rail of the fence.
