- 8 Far came by the noon mail.  
Pa sold a marriage license to a French man to marry a daughter of St. John's
- 9 Sunday. Rev Given gave a very good sermon from Daniel 2nd chap. It bore chiefly on Temperance Rev Smith of Luens preached in a very good sermon from Joshua 7th chap "Achan's sin". Mr Smith is collecting for Luens
- 10 Got Table & Betty shod. Jimie drew a load of coal from Lancaster for church
