The Eye in Diagnosis.

It has been estimated that from 70 to 75 per cent. of systemic diseases show some manifestations in the eye; so we can readily see the advantage of an examination of this organ. We will consider some of the common conditions, viz.:

Diseases of the Circulation.

(a) Valvular disease sometimes causes retinal hemorrhage, pulsation of the retinal vessels.

(b) Endorcarditis, embolism of the central artery of the

retina.
