over bbl Northern Spy apples in evening \$1.25 per bbl.

to help him and Chester and Bill Rea were here. We all
worked at turnips in AM only. We got in 3 loads
in AM. In PM Willie took 952 lbs oats to

him. Paid J. F. & W. G. \$5.00 the Reas 50cts

apples with 4 bushels oats \$1.40. We put 9
steers in to-day to fatten.
