I finished pulling $\frac{3}{4}$ mangles then drove down for 7 o M. P.M. we took in rest of $\frac{3}{4}$ mangles then I plowed some No 3. We pulled apples etc.

I drove 7 o M down before tea. Mr Cook came in 5 00 to tell us about his thrashing we paid him in full \$5.00 Willie at Jamesons thrashing P.M.
