**Temperatures for Irrigations and Baths.**

Temperature of irrigations for wounds, 98° to 100°; for ears, 90°; for hemorrhage, 105° to 120°; for vaginal douche, 100° to 110°; for subcutaneous saline, 100° to 105° Fahrenheit. Temperature of hot baths, 98° to 105°; warm bath, 85° to 95°; cold bath, 60° to 70°; hot dry air bath, 100° to 200°; vapor bath, 105° to 110° Fahrenheit. The quantities for an alkaline bath are: carbonate of soda, 5iv; hot water, gallons xxx. Quantities for sulphur bath: sulphuret of potass, 5iv; hot water, gallons xxx. For a starch bath the quantities are: starch 2 lbs. to hot water, gallons xxx.—*The Hospital.*
