Cloudy day breezy cool east wind rained
at night. We spread 7 loads manure
on rape land at S L (spr) got from yard
shophouse hot bed pigpen etc. Aunt Mary
Paulin came down with mail man. Melrose
got dinner here Willie drove bet to station
en route Guelph to catch 5 o'clock train
then came around by Albion fifty to see cattle
62 fess in buggy. We used Mand in spreader with
fess and Punch first time hitched since she
foaled we still put her out. Willie down
town at night got bread 70¢ its Mrs Behavio
over in evening paid for milk 50 cream 25
