 well 6th Randolph's Birth Day 1867
 Mowing in the upper Field Heavy Rain
 Thunder high Wind Mowed a Road in the
 oak Field Transfiguration of Christ Fine
 The Duke of Edinburgs Birth Day 1844 a Lot
 of Yowing The Garnet went up did not
 Get our Mail yesterday Leander crossed
 for the Mail 7th Lemays here in the
 Grove Liberty with them 8th Fine
 Began a stack Tugh wind did not
 finish it put 3 Loads in the Barn
 very windy gathering at the Lower
 Point and Raking Genie came
 from Cornwall had a pail of
 cherries Rained hard to night
 Heavy Thunder and Lightning
 Mercells wife and children came
 she was sick went home on the 9th

 Fine very hot Mowing in upper Field
 Rained Thunder Genie went off a Lot of
 Yowing a Lot of Hay out a most Holy
 Lot of Potato Bugs crawling about
 very hot and silly using new potatoes
 Rained and Thunder to night 10th Fine & W
 Stanley and I to Lewis for our Boat Mowing
 very hot commenced to Rain Thunder and
 Lightning heavy Rain Heard Peter Back
 was drowned taken in a Mastinonge
 as he was not very sober Rained to night
 hard 11th Raining to Day Fine Mowed
 some in the oak field water in it
 fixed the Lounge found a Bun or
 runt chicken Hawks coming around
 to Genie and Mr Conneby and 4 more there
 all night they are fishing Pickrel 12th
 they went off have me 1 Dollar for
 there trouble Rained all night and
 Rained to Day & Wind Rained to night
 cleaned the Stables 13th & Wind Rain
 Fine went to the Head of the Island cut
 some Thistles water high Leander crossed
 to Summerstown 13 room 15 2 Bars of soap 10
 Plug of Tobacco 10 Mr Gene came had a
 Plug of wire a Pail of Thuckle Berries
 and Black currants a Spade for Stanley
