

- Nov. 1 1875 I went this morning to <sup>with</sup> the Russian German  
 at Diller to help pull turnips then I & boys finished  
 drawing in corn 3 loads W pretty mild
- 2 Joe & German pulled turnips I brought home  
 chop a m pulled with her P m W pretty cold
- 3 drew in 9 loads turnips German sawed wood for my  
 mother. Finklers were here M. N. called few minutes  
 P m. W. cold frost here
- 4 I borrowed Hones's waggon drew 16 loads with 2 teams W  
 5 drew 5 loads a m. pulled a few P m. W. mild
- 6 I & little boys drew 5 loads & helped Joe finish P m  
 W. fine. Indian summer weather
- Sunday 7 I & Nancy & little boys went to meeting at the  
 remarks by B. C. sermon on <sup>by B. J. Hooper</sup>  
 8 I & boys finished drawing turnips 7 loads a. b. & his  
 mother called awhile P m. Joe began plowing east of  
 9 I took sow to Trans a m. took 21 bus <sup>orchard. W. elev</sup> potatoes to  
 Whitewalk @ 40¢ per bus W. pretty cold
- 10 Joe threshed Peas a m. I & boys husked corn. I & boys made  
 40 gals cider P m. W. rain a m. Cloudy P m
- 11 I brought home sow & plow <sup>W. clear this morning</sup>  
 12 I & Joe finished plowing below <sup>cloudy through the day. Mild</sup> Orchard he took his plow  
 to shop this evening. W. beautiful like Indian summer
- 13 Cleared Peas this morning then began plowing in pasture  
 field I & boys took in Potatoes out of pit. W. rain this  
 Sunday 14 at home all day B. C. was here a m. <sup>morning clear P m</sup> W. snow a m  
 Cloudy P m. about 3 in snow fell. mild
- 15 Joe was away a m. I went shooting little while  
 shot fine black squirrel Joe threshed Peas & I & Nancy  
 went to Whitewalk P m. W. mild a m. soft snow & rain P m
- 16 Put winter apples into Cellar & Joe threshed Peas  
 I fixed steps under kitchen doors & talked with B.  
 D. they came home from Pennsylvania this morning and  
 came here P m. W. mild. some soft snow
- 17 Joe threshed Peas I & boys took 6 ewes to B. C. N. then went  
 to J. D. Cleared Peas P m. I took 10 bus to Coles Grove  
 mill & Joe drew sawed wood into shed P m. W  
 18 Joe drew wood into shed I drew some <sup>cold cloudy</sup> 3 cord for my  
 mother W. mild. squalls of snow P m
