Mr James Cameron Island Aug 20<sup>th</sup>  
 in Williamson Allen & Mr Donald R. Dairiel  
 to Day in the Roman church for the first time  
 22<sup>nd</sup> Came Home Bought of Mr Ward  
 5 lb of Tea Janie Spinks Departed I seen  
 her last Breath as she left this World  
 Jupes and matches Gordon put me across  
 with 7 white Roses Boat Don Ward  
 went off on the 19<sup>th</sup> and the only Kepfer  
 came 23<sup>rd</sup> putting in Hay. Mourning 24<sup>th</sup>  
 very sick 25<sup>th</sup> Mourning forced the Jumper  
 putting in Bucky here got an old scythe  
 26<sup>th</sup> putting in Hay 27<sup>th</sup> Dan Summers here  
 early this morning very unwell 28<sup>th</sup>  
 got a Sturgeon and fish on the old man  
 line D Summers took 50 lbs of flour  
 from Dundee for me on Credit 29<sup>th</sup>  
 got 3 Sturgeon 30<sup>th</sup> the old man  
 from a Montreal Fisher for Corn and Butter  
 31<sup>st</sup> got a Line and 95 ft Hooke and Snoods  
 from the Old man Mr Drusker Randolph went  
 with the old man to Fish a fine Day Let the  
 Cows in shut the Back Door of the Barn  
 yesterday 1<sup>st</sup> of Sept Mourning in the upper  
 Field 2<sup>nd</sup> Taking in Corn that's ripe cutting  
 Putting cornstalks 3<sup>rd</sup> Danny Birth Day 1846  
 putting Hay on the Barn floor helping the  
 old man with his lines to set Laure and  
 Pranny Morris came Henry Bosell and  
 Leshey here with Puckerel for the old man  
 at 12 o'clock at night the old man off Henry  
 mad at him 4<sup>th</sup> Amiot for Butter Laure  
 went down to Kat Kat Wind Raised Black  
 cherries Rape taking in corn 5<sup>th</sup>  
 John Angus Birth Day 1850

Mr James Cameron Island Sept 6<sup>th</sup> 1875  
 Working at corn and cornstalks cutting in the upper  
 Field Grannie Laure and Dan Summers went home  
 Randolph had with a large Boat sent to Wardsfor Sea  
 Soda 7<sup>th</sup> Went to head of the Island 8<sup>th</sup> at Hay 9<sup>th</sup> at hay  
 10<sup>th</sup> Working at Hay in the upper Field 11<sup>th</sup> cutting cornstalks  
 12<sup>th</sup> Taking in corn 13<sup>th</sup> putting in hay 14<sup>th</sup> Sunday 15<sup>th</sup>  
 got the Boat from Dan Summers at Kat Kat  
 16<sup>th</sup> Went to Salmon River Tea flour soap salt  
 Castor oil salts R.R.R Matches 4 spools 3 yds overall stuff  
 Cotton Calico Braces Powder shot Hammer knife Button  
 scissors 2 Butter Tubs scythestone 17<sup>th</sup> went for nuts  
 18<sup>th</sup> at nuts 19<sup>th</sup> Raining 20<sup>th</sup> Dan Summers here Renshaw  
 here Andrew Cameron departed cut the Tobacco  
 21<sup>st</sup> Sunday Did not write down anything till  
 the 25<sup>th</sup> 25<sup>th</sup> Went to Hamiltons Heard  
 that fellow that murdered his Father Clark Brown  
 was sentenced to be hung on the last day of  
 October Heard Liza Bepond was married to the  
 Frenchman that lived with them Bought  
 Ward Tea Knitting needles got from Hamilton  
 25 cents 1 Bag of apples small crab apples very bad  
 with one hand dressed oil 30<sup>th</sup> at Hay 1<sup>st</sup> October  
<sup>2<sup>nd</sup> went with wool to Bosell</sup> Did not write anything 5<sup>th</sup> of October Sunday  
 David Bowen a fine lad in Drawing has  
 gun out of the Boat it went off and shot  
 him Dead about 13 years of age 6<sup>th</sup> at Hay  
 7<sup>th</sup> George Bosell and wife and 3 children here  
 8<sup>th</sup> 9<sup>th</sup> 10<sup>th</sup> Hugh Ann McMaster Birth Day I went to  
 Mill called at Lukes never heard David was dead  
 till Luke told me and showed me the spot  
 6 Bushels of Corn Bought 15 yds of Cotton 12 yds of Calico  
 12 yds of Batting 2 yds of Overall stuff 1 pair of Braces  
 1 lb q. ea 1 lb q. shot 2 Pounds of Paper Coal Bread Lead Pencils  
 matches 11<sup>th</sup> Cutting hay 12<sup>th</sup> 13<sup>th</sup> 14<sup>th</sup> 15<sup>th</sup> 16<sup>th</sup> 17<sup>th</sup> 18<sup>th</sup> 19<sup>th</sup> 20<sup>th</sup> I wrote  
 nothing in these days
