I hauled load manure from Steels one from Grahams and one from Smalls put them in pile No 6 I brought up windows from home for hot bed also some leaf mould from hardwood bush. Willie drove goats down to millinery opening in P.M. with Jennie they got better money from Mrs M. Vicar 50cts and from Mrs Wilson \$1.14. Jno Black got circular saw and jack to cut his wood. Mr and Mrs Murray Imp bank up for got cream.
