I cleaned out most of box steel. Willie drove 7 AM down about six PM took to Russell 12 dog eggs @ 19cts 228 got pattern 15cts on of paid A. Richardson for lather got in April 60cts got 'World' 1ct smoothing iron at Nichols \$2.00 also coal ~~###~~ tar ~~###~~
