Vomiting.—The vomiting supposedly due to the nauseating effect of the ether is of no special moment. The vomiting which persists is of a different type and may assume serious aspects. Sometimes an enema will relieve this condition by setting up a peristaltic action in the intestines and a passage of gas. Washing out the stomach with 2 or 3 glassfuls of warm water is sometimes all that is necessary. In other cases washing with the tube may be necessary and in still another group, in which the condition becomes a dilatation, nothing but systematic lavage every few hours will avail.—Balfour; Mayo Clinic, Med. Record.
