When dealing with the bladder, it must always be borne in mind that this viscus is very susceptible to irritative influences, and that an inflammation may be easily brought on. It is principally for this reason that the residual urine, that is in it, must be completely removed before making any instillations of nitrate of silver or other medicated solutions. Unless this precaution is taken untoward symptoms of a marked character will set in and ultimately lead to the development of a chronic cystitis which, in itself, is a most troublesome and inconvenient condition, often requiring a surgical operation.—*Amer.
