30 1304 06 continued Thursday forward 1639 52 445 49 783 70 79 87  
 sold to Marshall \$112.50 cheque weighing 10 cts. I turned out hay in coals No 7. Willie went to Cooks and Barbours thrashings PM. I hauled in 4 small loads hay to other barn goats helped off with them brought the 5th over here put the 4 in other barn. Many walked down home and got back through the fields.

October 1

## Friday

Cloudy rained PM and evening. Willie at Jamson's thrashing till 4 PM Mr Fursay up till 2 PM he plowed in morning No 5 and I spread out hay coals No 7 then we got Amory Ford to help us and we got in two loads to other barn by noon Fursay & I put the last load on as it started to rain brought it over here thus finishing haying Paid Fursay 90 cts Mr Cook over at noon got kind of barley fork he was to put a handle on it I cleaned silo walls etc We kept the horses in to night so rainy.

## Saturday

Mostly fine sunny, cloudy at times warmer. Willie took cream down sent engine castings to Dummick cost 35 cts express took 4 pigs to Wilsons weighed 680 lbs at \$9.70 per unit \$66.00 he bought 53 bushels less 20 lbs oats from Jim Horne he brought them up and had dinner here we paid him \$18.35 cheque P.B. oats 35 cts bushel. A black squirrel crossed over field below house and got up in Mackies maple tree. Willie also took sheep to Wilsons paid 17 cts got groceries at 70 cts charged. we fixed fence in No 6 to make lane to No 7 PM then Willie went down for sheep it was not done so got 2 boys who did on
