Gynecological Hints.

When possible it is best to operate for laceration of the perineum before the placenta has been delivered. There is less annoyance from bleeding. The best material is chromicized gut No. 3. It cuts less than silkworm gut and does not annoy the patient so much. The sutures should not be drawn too tight, for there is always swelling of the parts that will cause strangulation. A very good needle to use is a full curved three-inch Hagedorn.—Waldo; Int. Journ. of Surg.
