Arthur over in the evening. the youngsters gone to Montague they
were told to stay all night - if it rained hard, Paul took the basket
to Harveys. at night. caught a mess of fish. rained some in the
Wed 7. Terrible high southwest wind. something awful. a little rain in
the morning. Marjorie baking bread. something awful. a little rain in

on the evening the wind kept rising until it was something
dreadful the house shook like an old ship Will's barn
roof nearly gone I never felt the wind like it on my
life time. I cleaned the stove pipe or I believe it would
blow on fire. the two hives blew over at 8 o'clock &

Sun 11. Easter Sunday. our preaching here the minister
has a cold. Marjorie Marquerite started down to Clifton then
over the river. Hattie went up after dinner to see Clara & the baby
I went down after I got the work done I swept &
dusted the school house the wind was 2 miles thick in the boys
side there was a terrible storm southwest wind blowing on
the I don't know when the dust would have settled I told
Jordan to go to the old house while I was down there. the boys
went out to I blacked the stove. Arthur came home from
