

- May 17 Sown 45 lbs of carrot seed on the place east of the garden placed part of the potato ground & some corn
18 finished planting the potato ground & dragg ready to furrow out also had a meeting of the town to lay the foundation of the Schoolhouse & some money was raised for the meeting to day fine steady rain all day
19 got the horses Shad & drew some rails to the west fence north field they were taken away last Friday
20 worked at the fence & settled with P. Clark paid him 15 dollars & account fine growing time
21 finished the fence in the forenoon sawing about 100 barrels of plaster on the field below the house
even 23 fine rain last night & this morning the young helped me to turn up part of the middle fence in the morttale field fine growing time made
24 washed the sheep Samuel Thompson & Son helped me fix'd part of the fence in the lane
25 attended a school meeting or meeting to select a new site or see if the people will build
26 we have the foundation is laid they value it at a hill 16 for the hill 13 for the lot at the station the Revd Mr. Weire preached in the school house
27 planted better then two pools of the Early Rose potato in the garden & four half rows of sweet corn next the path & house & the rest of the rest in common in the forenoon heavy rain then tried to plant the ground
28 cut some potatoes went & laid out the foundation of the school house on the hill the ground is very hard
rain 29 bored & made a pair of barbunks
30 made another barbunk can do very little there is rain almost every day
31 drew a load of stones for Mr. Thompson that load there was 2 bushels 1 lb
