- 19 Pigeon Ironmaster got key of house opposite Wingham. Jimmie got his boots fixed last week by Pigeon cost 1⁰⁰. Threshed Monday 19 bush wheat none oats, today thrash 150
- 20 Began to rain about dark and rained 24 hours, not a heavy shower at any time finished threshing in afternoon had 243 bush oats in all. Brown Surveyor came last evening about 4. stayed all night. Had a letter from Jimmie he got to Brockville all right and got a
