W. Home and Foreign M. met in vestry. I was not there. It was wild
- 7 Fine and bright. but cold wind. Mrs Supper had a baby girl last night. 70 1 lb butter 30 matches 35
The boys left for Cornwall to hockey match Wms town and Internationals Wms. won 3 to 2
Katie Christie here all night
- 8 Just a common day. 70 3/4 Butter 30 pr lb 95 95
- 9 Stormy day not very cold off B. fund 25. Missions 50 75
- 10 Monday
- 11 Am 42 day 35⁰⁰ Very fine day. 35
- 12 Fine bright day looks like a vap day
- 13 Mild day snow melting away 70 1 gall coal oil 20
Jimmie sold longboat to W. Abram for \$145.00
- 14 Mrs McDermid had a sale today of household things she is going to Alberta to join her husband she sent a car full off on Wednesday 12th 9 cows 1 pig buggy cutter and furniture. Phnoon Rayman went in the car with her own boy
- 15 Snow then in afternoon a storm of rain hail with thunder and lightning. Jimmie was out at the back, and was under it all
