- Thurs May 3. Rather dull and misty at first, cleared and very warm, I cleaned east Verandah, no fire in little stove.
- Fri May 4. Fine and very warm an extreme change, I cleaned north Verandah, Mrs Neil McDonald called, I was at Annies as Grant and Jessie in for cards.
- Sat May 5. Very warm untill noon a shower then cleared and quite cool, no fire needed as houses still warm, Annies Recital 3 P.M., Juggie and children remained, so I was there.
- Sun May 6. Fine bright day, quite cool but pleasant, I was at Church, lighted fire in <sup>stove</sup> afternoon, Annis here at night.
- Mon May 7. Fine and bright, varnished chairs, painted south Verandah, at Annies
- Tue May 8. Fine and warmer, Varnished Coal Oil Stove, went to Mrs Foss, the girls Club entertained the mothers.
- Wed May 9. Fine and warm a perfect day, I went to Mr Charltons funeral, called at J. Speights but she was out.
- Thurs May 10. Fine and bright, got lawn mower fixed 75 cts but had to go back, cut grass first time, no fire for a couple of days.
