 Nov 14 Hugh McRoy came to build the chimney got it up into
 the garrat Wallace helped Thome & Ad plowed at the road
 15 Hugh McRoy finished the chimney Thome attended on
 him I helped Wallace at his Sellar we blasted out the rock
 16 Thome drew some old wood out of our bush
 I helped Wallace we blasted & quarried out the rock
 in the forenoon I met Mr Cumberland at the station
 in the afternoon to ask him to Mr Stevens to board
 Ad back Mr Cumberland to Fairfax he went to East
 17 ^{rain} ¹⁴ ~~May~~ there was no one came he preached here at
 18 I took Mr Cumberland to Mr Shields his daughter ^{night}
 is dead she was buried at the Ebenezer he preached
 there was a large funeral very bad roads with
 Ad got the horses shod at Whites Thome & Ad greeted ^{some}
 19 we worked at the house got it nearly done
 20 finished the grouting this morning Ad finished plowing
 the green soil at the road the ground is so wet and so ^{nothing}
 21 I worked at the house Thome drew loam from ^{at the stable}
 the pit to cover the clay about the house ^{one warm}
 22 ^{rain} rain and snow all day no work down out
 of doors we fixed some in the house
 23 raining most of the night snowed & rained
 most of the day Thome went to Esatt to get horse
 Beasts mended I met the Rev Mr Sage at the ^{station}
 24 ²⁴ Rev Mr Sage preached this morning Mr Grant at night
 25 ~~Thome~~ that some show to the road drew some sand
 to the house & brought a load of lime & snow
 26 Thome drew some to cover the clay round
 the house I collected school tax in the village
 in the afternoon Ad & Wallace plowed at the station
 27 I collected the upper part of the section this forenoon Thome
 drew some to the house when it was not raining
 28 Thome & Shondie & scraped part of the Barnyard on
 rathen finished it in the forenoon he drew saw
 dust to make a ramp to the Barn so as to cover the mill
 I mended some boats in the forenoon Rev Mr Sage here
 29 Thome brought plank today at the place of the field
 we laid it down the mill was mended some put a back to be split and
 plowed again to the mill
 I mended some boats on rathen mended the lawn part of the section
 today Ad went to the mill with Thome & some to look a mill to
 see if it would run with the mill
