- 23 Fine day
- 24 Muddy was away today, This is Emma Stevens wedding day. Pa is not so well
- 25 Very fine day. 75^{cts} doz lemons 10. 18^{cts} lb prunes 15^{cts} Jimmie got his boots soled at Redgeons 1-25. And is to get 2 pair tried 25
- 26 Fine bright day. I was not out to paid 30^{cts} there was no preaching last Sunday in Morning, and Pa did not send it for evening
- 27 Wind rain and snow. Mrs Kennedy came I did not keep her
- 28 Fine but cold. I called in afternoon on Mrs Mrs Buchanan, Jessie McLaughlin, at Sullivan's. They were resting. I called at Mr McLaughlins. Saw Mrs Bethune. Called at Duncan Saddlers. They were well. Saw Louise & Donald, McGillis. 75^{cts} lb tea 30
- 29 Cold in morning. At 8 A.M. below zero. The sacred concert came off and was a success, took in over \$2.00 all done well. Jessie McLaughlin was in fine voice. Mr Gregory & Brown both done well. 4 P.M. Mr & Mrs Buchanan called to see us they are very nice. Louise McGillis and Jennie Saddler called. Mrs Kennedy 42^{cts} doz 25^{cts} doz lemons 30
- 30 Cold and bright. Jimmie Lippie and Coy spent the evening here. Muddy got home from Lanesville
- 31 Jimmie by sugar 25^{cts} below zero at 7 A.M. Boys and Bridie went to spend the forenoon at Mr Sheds. 4th Lanesville. Furquihers birthday

- 1 Saturday, Nice day. Our folk are sleeping off the fatigue of the party last night. 70 1 gall. cod oil 20
- 2 Began to snow and blow about 7 A.M. now 4.30 P.M. still stormy. The roads will be completely blocked, we have a drift in front of the woodshed over 4 feet high
- 3 9.30 P.M. Stormed all last night, and all day, now calming down. Bridie and Tatie went to school they had no few pupils that they came home there was no mail. The Moccasin did not go down until 1 P.M. Jimmie and Mr Crommons are auditing the Municipal books at Tom's
- 4 Shoveling out the roads
- 5 Pretty cold and drifting
- 6 Cold. I went to W.F.M. I at Archie Squires. Muddy drove May and ^{me} there. The roads are very bad Mrs A. C. took me home, my off 25
- 7 Stormy day. D.H. Mc Luman, S.B. was buried at his home today. he died of pneumonia. This was our preparatory day before Sacrament Rev Matheson of Sumnerstown preached to a small congregation. Mercury was 20 below zero in morning
- 8 Still stormy. Mr Langel preached, not many out another death on the Branch John Young Black Grant, died last night will be buried tomorrow. 75^{cts} lb tea 15^{cts} 15
- 9 Still stormy, not many in church. I never saw so small a communion in St Andrews church
- 10 A fine cool day. Sunshine in afternoon. Muddy left after dinner to go to the 8th Lockiel will not be back until Friday. The roads are very heavy. Bridie got Mabels picture and Mr. Kintice picture
- 11 Fine bright day but cold. Baked in oven. Got a Dawn calendar from Kandy
