Baburston helped dug 34 bushels that is 74 bushels

rain 26 heavy rain last night all day I went to J. Fries
to see if he had sawed any lumber yet he had ^{nothing}

27 heavy rain all day the Rev. Mr. Garry preached at night

28 finished digging the potatoes have about 100
bushels they are good very heavy digging the
ground is so very wet Michel Casstow & Tom helped

29 worked at the carrots got them all dug M. & Sam
Casstow helped me

30 got the harness had rather freezing I went
to get a harness tomorrow

31 went to Kingston for the year with me fine day
