- 8 rain snow is going very fast Ad and Henry Fairer came home at noon from the 9th Con
- 9 the Revd Mr Taplin preached in the church this evening
- 10 Ad & Henry went out with J. Bradley & C Rath to help them to run lines on to 11 in the 9th Commission
- 11 Ad & Henry did not come home to day probably snow stormy this forenoon heavy snow fine afternoon
- 12 fine day I went out Wallace W. Vail's Sale he is sailing off all his cows & some of them went up to 47¢ & 50 cents price George Richardson seven dollars of fines to give to his Father as Treasurer
- 13 Ad & Henry & David got home this afternoon Ad & Henry went to the 9th Con to get out stuff for building fine day David went to give lines for 5 Segg little snow
- 14 I attend to the cattle fine day taped a few trees
- 15 taped the rest of the trees in all Ad came home from the 9th Commission Rain this afternoon
- 16 the Revd Mr Taper preached this morning in the church
- 17 Ad & Henry went to the 9th Commission fine day came home at night for saw oil of Whiskey one of the horses cut her foot being rain after night collected 13 pails of Sap boiled it at the house
