28 Friday
Fine sunny cool. We spread 7 loads manure A.M. on Turnip land. P.M. we sowed 32 more rows corn 8 or 10 of them W.No 7. rest W.C.G.D. I worked at fence some. I went to meeting of managers at night. Mr Elliot resigned as caretaker.

29 Saturday
Fine sunny cool. I finished getting fence between No 6 and bush in shape to keep cattle in Willie plowed and harrowed No 4. 3 horses he took Punch down at noon bred her to Young Lapidist (blood) got Columbus harness oil at station \$1.50 took 12 doz eggs to F & S \$2.16 got fine apple 15 soda biscuit 25 its balance 176 m. d. Willie down at night got tooth attended to at Nothens got stamps Phillips
45 10 to punch Nichols 10 its backing soda Ellis 5 its settled F & S corn a/c as follows 2,320 lbs corn got 18th \$37.70 got cash for eggs took on 18th \$2.16. 216
39 40 balance of 27th 211 balance of to-day \$1.76 he also 387
