got drill at Dolton. \$1.²⁵ 1 25
got 3.30th corn at Hewers
5¹/₂ bu corn at Hewers at 58¢ 3.19

Sunday 17th fine & cool
Father, Mother & I went to church. heard Rev. John W.C. Dougall of North west tell us a story of his North west life among the Indians.

Monday 18th fair
we chored & I shoo seven sheep and went to town
~~shooed~~ ~~two~~. 2 got rams
got Cultivator at Penfolds
I am to pay them ten dollars difference sold. Cabbage. 2.⁰⁰ 2.⁰⁰ 10.⁰⁰
