5 Brockville folks the Seatts & Ellen went away on the night train to Brockville the Revd W Bell come on the Express he is to preach two sabbaths for us he is staying near Cold Spring

6 I split wood & other fixing about the house Revd W Bell preached here this morning I am not able to go I had a cold chill in bed all day

7 no better a severe pain in my side Ad is doing the chores 9 Ad brought Dr Renee to see me he says that it is inflammation of the lungs

10 Stormy day Revd W Bell had a prayer meeting in the church to night

11 Revd W Bell went to Fairfax this evening to hold a meeting there 12 stormy day Ad telegraphed to Ferrisville for Dr Addison he is sick & could not come he then telegraphed to Brockville for Dr Menolan he came up on the Express he sounded & examined me he says I have one good lung, thinks there is no danger but he can

13 he sent up a bottle for the cough it is very bad the Revd W Bell preached at night here

14 the Revd W Bell went to Kingston on the Express the roads very bad almost impassable they had to shovel the roads to get W Bell home from Fairfax to day he was then seen Thursday
