^{Wed} Sept 21st cloudy rain in the evening we was husking corn most of the day.

^{Thu} Sept 22nd fore part of the day wet, we were sorting over corn this fore noon, after noon I was making a trough to feed grain to sheep, Alice started for home this evening, John Spraint his ankle.

^{Fr} Sept 23rd cloudy and cold. I was husking. Walter was plowing.

^{Sat} Sept 24th cloudy and warm, I was husking. Walter plowing.

^{Sept} 25th clear and cool.

^{Mon} Sept 26th clear fore noon and warm. a sharp frost last night the first to kill vines here. Walter finished plowing, I was husking.

^{Tue} Sept 27th cloudy and warm, we were husking and drawing in corn.

^{Wed} Sept 28th cloudy and warm, we were husking and drawing in corn, the girls went to Florence Nelson's funeral.

^{Thu} Sept 29th cloudy and moderate we was husking and drawing in corn.

^{Fr} Sept 30th cloudy and foggy in the fore noon after noon flying clouds and warm we were husking and drawing in corn.
