- 5 Mr McKay of Summerstown preached. got 1 pan bread 25
- 6 Presser went off yesterday. passing 18 tons at 1.25. 22.50
- 6 Collection for aged ministers, & French evangelists. Pa gave one dollar. Brid 100 1-
- 7 The Sabbath School picnic our folk. went in ^{light} waggon. pa & I got painters horse and went in the buggy. got 1 pan bread 25
- 8 paid 50. for the horse. 25 for the island 75
- 9 On our way home we were at Uncle Donald and at Coulers got the carpet torn 4.57 4 57
- 10 it rained we left the carpet at Donald. got home about dark.
- 8 Had a good deal of cleaning. Pinner went ^{to Sunday} to Sunday.
- 9 Jimmie went away this morning to do some work for D.D. McDonald on the K.R. at St Jerome. Gave him \$5.00. Got down last night 5-25
- 10 Baked today. Began to clean sitting room.
- 11 Pa started for Caladonia. Murdy drove him with
