Saturday

Fine sunny day very warm. I cut some
 more hay in No 7 in morning then S.D. Roked
 Willie so cultivated corn 2 horses then went
 down town before dinner got from Beggs
 \$20.00 for lambs got meat at Beggs 90c
 (but forgot it so Melville Hill went down for it
 at noon.) fork handle at Mennie 20c
 Paris green Phillips 60c wheat for chickens
 at P & L \$1.30. 300 lbs barley dust at Wall
 \$4.05 goods at Simmons on top bag salt etc
 S.D. Stanley and M Hill up all day hoing
 turnips helping with hay. P.M. we put hay
 fork in other barn hauled in 6 loads hay to it
 one horse also some on other waygon leaving.
