Sun Jan 8th cloudy and moderate. Snow last night.

Mon Jan 9th cloudy a moderate winter day I was thrashing peas. Walter drawing wood.

Tue Jan 10th a blustering day and cold, was thrashing peas part of the fore noon. the rest of the day was piling wood in the shed.

Wed Jan 11th clear and cold, was thrashing peas part of the day, started for Dresden to attend the Division Grange there was some mistake and it put off until Tuesday.

Thu Jan 12th clear fore part of the day, later part cloudy, high wind from the South a prospect for rain the thermometer at zero this morning, I was thrashing out peas Walter was drawing wood.

Fri Jan 13th clear fore part and soft. Snow last night high wind today, very cold this evening, took a load of grain to Mill to get chopt.

Sat Jan 14th clear a pleasant day, not doing much myself, if the boys went for chop feed.

Sun Jan 15th clear and cold.

Mon Jan 16th clear and cold, I was thrashing out peas part of the day, Walter was laying some fence the wind blew down and taking care of the stock.

Tue Jan 17th cloudy and snow, I attended Division Grange at Dresden.

Wed Jan 18th clear part of the day and pleasant, I was not doing anything to day.

Thu Jan 19th cloudy and snow, was thrashing peas most of the day, Walter attending stock.

Fri Jan 20th clear and cold, was shelling corn, and was settling up with Billon Snary.

Sat Jan 21st clear and cold, we were cleaning up a load of corn & oats to get chopt.

Sun Jan 22nd clear and pleasant attended Sabbath School and preaching.
