Fine day not quite so cold snowing a little in evening. I Sargent and a horse buyer here in AM looking at horses. Girls down town in PM with Lucy got 40cts for letter Mrs. Thro two picture post cards 5cts We sold rags horse hair & rubber to Rag man 55-. Father up a room with seeds arid coke. I cut wood in brush and brought up load in wagon. 4 loads to date first time long day Saturday morning.

Ground white with snow this morning snowing more or less all day cold weather.

Willie drove Bella down home in morning to do painting of house. He got at Mills meat \$2 I cleaned seed oats to-day. Alex Mills came in PM bought heifer Brody for \$44.00

To go Thursday got in hand \$1.00 Bella came up in evening she got paint 90cts We sent to J. Sommerville Toronto \$5.20 for Anna Tamie 7 and 3^{1/2} portages Sold 1lb butter Atkins 24cts Wm Armstrong over \$2.00 if we'd get some hay

Willie took 12.65 lbs pig chop to Linton and brought up load manure from Jim Dunn in AM In PM went for chop 55cts took Dick down to Lubington sold him for \$205.00 then we brought over load turnips from just Lizzie Mc Donald up for tea and evening. Mr. Bible here in AM looking at cattle. We bought a mare 3 yrs old and colt 2 yrs old from Tom \$325.00
