Planted corn east of the Barn on where we had potatoes last year put the corn that took the premium at Delta on the first 2 ridges all but the last row the rest is our own AD had a plowing bee in the north field & teams got a good job done

Rev. Mr. Brown preached this morning Mr. Nicholson at night

3 AD plowed for three potatoes at the road and made out his report of the Road at Doerly's corner

4 little rain this morning AD came & dragged the summer fallow Wallau rolled the Peas and oats north of the house then rolled summer fallow

Mr. Bigg came up on the mixed staped all night

5 AD sowed 3 bushel of Buckwheat in the north field ^{went across the road} middle part it is intended to plow under for manure he dragged rolled sowed then dragged

6 very hard frost last night & this morning the potatoes & cucumbers is all frozen at the station no AD sowed 1 bushel of Buckwheat in north field ^{damage here}

7 rain this afternoon he went to the road in the afternoon

8 AD drew 2 loads of wood from Bruce's this forenoon he planted potatoes at the road in the afternoon I attended an Agriculture meeting

Rev. Mr. Nicholson preaches this morning Mr. Brown at night

10 put the stove out in the forenoon I went to Mr. Reardon's & received 4 dollars for 2 days Sunday last year & 7 dollars 53 cents for cloaths that got for Jennie Kenne which paid to Joseph Taylor & Mrs. Fullerton ^{for the} stuff & making

11 we sheared the sheep in the forenoon I went through the early potatoes in the afternoon

12 went to the funeral of Stanton Zahurston he was buried at the Green Church Rev. Messrs. Corral and Ruston officiated there a very large funeral 18 teams

13 went to the Laying of the Corner stone of the St. James Church it was laid by the Deaf Grand Master of the Free Masons there was good money there they had dinner in the grove 50 cents apiece

14 I went to Gonzague to assist in a case of selling liquors on Sabbath day one case was not proven the other was as usual till the witness did not appear
