I finished cutting rest of hay No 7 9 AM Willie went down town in morning got at Deans rope for loader 35 cts at Menzies more rope for loader 58 cts, at Wordens bit & snaps 20 cts at Mitchells rubbers 10 cts at Jamesons fruit cherries & bananas 90 cts at Forts bread & buns 11 cts. N.S. up all day hoeing corn A.M. helping with hay P.M. Willie S & D Raked P.M. we got 3 loads hay to other barn one horse put on with loader. We dropped pig & horse in evening. Wm. Stewart came for black 'Aiken' hifer P.M. Uncle Jim up in evening with bag of flour.
