C. Mc Donells sale. Sent a letter to Birdie
- 3 Dull day, gentle rain. To 4 lb sausage 40 paid 30 for Saturdays sausage. Ridgeman paid \$3.00 for April
- 4 Raymond put tin on our workhouse. 44.91 etc. To 3 tin pans 12<sup>00</sup> for peace 12-36 This has been a fine day, Muddy did not get back yet
- 5 To 2 pans bread 48 Fine day Gave Phillimore 4 bush of barley, sowed it
- 6 Fine planted 11 rows potatoes at burn To 1/2 lb steak 15. 2 lb butter from factory Began to rain about 6 P. M. Gave 8 bush of oats to Phillimore, sowed it and
- 7 Not many in church
- 8 Muddy went north, rain in afternoon
- 9 Muddy went away again
- 10 I am trying to make soap. Done some washing. I caught wife called 2 lb sausage 20
- 11 Pa had John Salway working yesterday and 9 hours today 2 95<sup>00</sup> shingled the steps of Kent rail house. Jimmie made a hen coop got wire netting 5<sup>00</sup> a yd 1.50 Sold 3 doz & 4 eggs - 44 - had a blue bill 46 Got 6 papers garden seed 30, 3 3/4 molasses 2 yds lead trimming 24, 1 3/4 yds flannel 8 etc dish cloth 15 etc. Phillimore drew hay on 9th Put out 5 sheets wire other things Gave 8 bush oats 2 bush barley to Docat on the 9th

- 11 To four loaves bread 24
- 12 Phillimore 10 bush oats, Muddy bot 5 bags oats 24 For came this evening. pan bread 24
- 13 To 4 lb sausage 40<sup>00</sup> made a little butter 40
- 14 Fine day, a large congregation, Rev. A. M. Gill sawy preached
- 15 Light showers in morning, heavy rain about noon Liberty Mc Lennan, Down, buried today
- 16 Fine day, Cariboo Cameron was injured in a well at St Raphaels, Birdie has a son
- 17. Mill Cameron, Cariboo, died at H. Ridgeman last night. Put the cows to pasture Marion came today. To 3 lbs sausage 30 tick
- 18. Rain in showers, Katie had a snow cold last night
- 19 Marion and I went to see Birdie she is pretty well so is her Ruby, and Agnes To 8 loaves 48. Jimmie sowed some beets 48
- 20 The weather is cold. H. Ridgeman 1/2 day in garden. 50<sup>00</sup> Mags drew a gag of hay, To 4 lb sausage 40<sup>00</sup> paid the 30 of the 11th. To 10 pounds. churned a little butter 80
- 21. Still cold, have fire in furnace Mr. M. Kingie of Lancaster preached, Mr. Govan was in Lancaster
- 22. Fine day To 2 lbs butter 46<sup>00</sup> Got cheese 44<sup>00</sup>
- 23 Soap cone 20 etc. tick Garden seeds 25<sup>00</sup>
- 24 ~~Phillimore~~ paid Jimmie went to Cornwall. Out 3 bush of Potatoes for Phillimore. Got them from James Abraham 90 etc per bag, Muddy by 6 loaves 24
- 25. Our folks did not get home yet. Jimmie planting our garden. Rev. A. M. Gillivroy and Mr. Govan were here, Pa gave ten dollars towards Queens. I sold 2 doz eggs 30 etc. Got 1 lb tea 25. 1/2 lb tea 20, ginger 10 Gave 2<sup>00</sup> to Jimmie 2.10 myself. 40 for butter 55
