- 29 Rained all day, got 1 gall kerosene oil
- 30 There was a fall accident happened to a Miss Johnson coming from Hepsala preaching the horse ran away, she was thrown out against a tree, she lived about two hours and a half  
Mr Elder gave the morning address in our church, and Mr Jensen in the evening. He is a Temperance lecturer
- 31 Fine warm day, rained a little in the morning Mrs A Thomas paid \$2<sup>00</sup> for her month rent in advance paid it on Saturday  
There was a McMan came here Sunday and asked for something to eat, he is a stranger, came from Scotland in April

December 1892

28 A fine bright-day school meeting. Billy Black checked before the other party came to the meeting. There is to be no election of Councilors. The candidates agreeing among themselves who would run got 7 lb tea at J.A.'s 40 cts - 1 gall and oil 16, Mrs St Thomas paid \$2.00
