- Frid 26 Another fine day. Italian cut down tree 22 from lower gate front lawn
- Sat 27 Fine warm day. The Mexican ploughing on lots at the house. 2 loaves 22. Milk 65
- " Yesterday John brought a crock of butter over 12 lbs Mrs Leitch and Kate Charley called
- Sun 28 Lovely morning General fund 25
- Mon 29 Dan Christie was here just when I was dressing in morning. Heavy rain today.
- Tues 30 Dan went to Cornwall yesterday, got back today. Had dinner at the Mansel will stay here over night. To coal oil 25=25 2 loaves 21⁰⁰

- Wed 1 Dull day 4 loaves 42⁰⁰ Dan Christie left for home this morning. Mrs Gair came in after prayer meeting. She looks well
- Thurs 2 Hunt Mexican, drilling our meadow for potatoes Charges 50⁰⁰ per hour. work came to 5.50
- Frid 3 Molasses 11⁰⁰ per lb 55⁰⁰ William Tait called
- Sat 4 Milk 56. 2 loaves 22
- Sun 5 G. F. 25, Hugh Robertson and Clifford McIntyre were here to tea. They left their horse here and went with Jimmie in the car to a Memorial service in Sutherlands Church Lancaster, for Stewart McArthur & McLucig
- Mon 6 Am paid 3⁰⁰ Ann 70⁰⁰
- Tues 7 2 loaves 22. rolled oats 30. Jimmie got at Lancaster 3 bags potatoes, broke cobbler 2.25 per bag - 6.75. Italian digging garden, 2 per day
- Wed 8 Planted some potatoes. It began to rain Muddy went to Montreal. Italian working
- Thurs 9 Muddy got home in forenoon. Jimmie planted onion sets. Got the eggs 40. from D. McCremon
- Frid 10 Mrs Christie down. Began to rain about 4.30 P.M. 2 loaves 21⁰⁰
- Sat 11 Milk 56. 2 loaves 21. Gave Jimmie \$15⁰⁰. Agnes did not get home yesterday. She mopped the hall & dining room swept Jimmie's room (fies)
- Sun 12 General fund 25. Missions 2.00. Mother's day raining all day. John a ham of veal 25
- Mon 13 Raining today Jimmie left to go to Ottawa tomorrow with the deputation about exemption storm thunder lightning on Friday night and thunder and lightning Sunday evening
