 A.M. I began to sow Oats in big field P.M. W. warm  
 12 G finished sowing big field with Oats John gauged <sup>east</sup> of  
 Orchard it is rather rough for the seedler I sowed some  
 it with fine wheat W. Clear. windy  
 13 G harrowed big field & finished plowing western  
 part of field behind barn about 3 1/2 acres we  
 intend to follow the rest of I & I gauged rest of  
 field east of Orchard, except strip east  
 of ~~the~~ Creek too soft then sowed with  
 fine wheat John & Harwin brought home  
 great this evening. W. Clear. windy Cool  
 Sunday 14 all went to meeting at Cedar Grove  
 remarks by B. C. Sermon on Hebrews 11  
 by Rev. J. Hoover we went to D. D. P. M.  
 John & girls went to B. S. W. Cool  
 15 G harrowed east part of field east of dam  
 then sowed Peas with seedler I sowed west part  
 of fallow behind barn with Peas by hand I brought  
 John harrowed it then began to roll Spring  
 wheat W. Clear. rather Cool  
 16 G finished sowing Peas 12 bus east of dam  
 then harrowed it. Then sawed wood John rolled  
 all day. I & Harwin went to Markham & Sunday 28 I & Harwin  
 D. A. Ranier to dinner. W. fine. Cool air  
 17 John finished rolling our Springs Coop. G sawed  
 wood A.M. helped me kill 2 runt pigs P.M.  
 W. warm as June. we have had an exceptional  
 early spring. Cattle & sheep are running in the  
 woods. grass is coming nice & green fall wheat  
 looks well. trees are beginning to bud fine  
 18 I & John went to Toronto, sold 2 pigs @ \$6.00  
 per cut Oats @ \$6.05 eggs @ 11¢ W. fine warm  
 Good Friday 19 went to meeting at Hebron  
 & sermon on Isaiah 53 C by B. C. went to North  
 Barkholder's P.M. W. very fine warm a little  
 20 Made some straight fence west of <sup>rain this morning</sup> barn  
 & drove stakes around calf pasture I went to D. D.  
 & saw his pigs W. a little rain A.M. warm P.M.  
 things are growing very fast

April 21 all went to meeting at Hebron  
 remarks by B. C. sermon on at Mark 16 C by  
 J. Pos. B. K. Ann Sherrick was here P.M.  
 staying all night W. Cool north wind. Clear  
 Monday 22 at home all day W. east wind. rain P.M.  
 3 Chores. G split wood. W. Squally  
 I took Nancy & Ann Sherrick to A. B.'s this morning  
 Ann Press got sick on ~~the~~ the road. had to leave  
 at A. B.'s got some medicine for her came home  
 left for W. Cloudy, Am. rain & very heavy  
 turn of wind P.M. not much wind here  
 5 went this morning to bring home man. is  
 all night again. G split wood A.M. Carried  
 out of Cedar P.M. W. fine Clear  
 heard that a brick school house on Brock  
 4<sup>th</sup> Con Pickering was partly <sup>erected</sup> unroofed  
 6 finished carrying Potatoes & helped <sup>erected</sup> D. H. have  
 on a load of our hay A.M. Cleaned wheat  
 M. W. fine warm Clear  
 7 G was at home today I & boys Chores  
 M. went to D. M. P.M. boys fished & brought  
 22 suckers W. foggy A.M. Clear P.M.  
 Sunday 28 I & Harwin & boys went to meeting  
 & Wileman's remarks by B. C. sermon on  
 Mat part of 18 C by Rev. J. Hoover  
 went to C. B. Hoover's P.M. W. Showers P.M.  
 Cut seed Potatoes W. rain all day I went  
 Whitval P.M. to Telegraph a message to Dr. Frel  
 C. Keturah has a very bad cough a good while  
 I & John went fishing with J. D. & Lottem  
 65 A.M. G & John pulled Pigeon  
 P.M. I went to Cherrywood W. fine Clear  
 1 Pulled down & built up bush fence  
 11<sup>th</sup> Con W. fine Clear. I & Harwin went to  
 low Grove after supper <sup>Dunkin act in force</sup>  
 chored A.M. drove stakes in bush fence P.M.  
 steady light rain A.M. Clear P.M.  
 went to Bee at meeting house putting up poles &  
 raising up graveyard. W. some rain A.M. P.M.
