Went to Mr. Jackson this afternoon & received a promise from him to take the apples at 40¢/bbl.

Mr. Leemore & I continued our programme of settlement also and seem likely to get through all right.

1896

Friday 23d

Had Mr. Neela part of the time to day so well we get in the last of the overseed. Succeeded in finishing the job this afternoon at a quarter past four o'clock.

Had quiet time by ~~down~~ your ^{co} altogether.

My mother is still in the same condition and unlikely I am afraid to stay with her longer. Dr. Bennett is here this afternoon for his second visit.
