Mary Boyington went to ~~W~~ Wakeburg last night her sister is sick I was batching to day

Fri Aug 30th cloudy and warm. there was thunder this mornin a few drops of rain not enough to any good not doing anything but setting in the

Sat Aug 31st cloudy and cool. I wrote a letter to Catharine Brock

Sun Sept 1st cloudy and cool.

Mon Sept 2nd light clouds and morning evening cool. I picking up a few onions and keeping Batch

Croton September 1901

Tue Sept 3rd clear and hot and dry. I went down to the old home to help Dick with his beans but had stopt pulling

Wed Sept 4th clear and hot. I finishd cutting my bit of corn this fore noon. Butler Pilton was here this after noon. Mrs Boyington not back yet. heard this morning the death of William Smith

Thu Aug Sept 5th clear and hot. I attended the funeral of the late William Smith there very large prosession. and road dreadfull dusty. house keeper not back yet

Fri Sept 6th clear most of the day and hot I was helping Dick fork beans.

Sat Sept 7th clear and hot. I bunched beans for Dick the fore part of the day.

Sun Sept 8th clear and hot

Mon Sept 9th cloudy and cool. I was turing beans for Dick part of the day.

Tue Sept 10 cloudy and warm a fine rain last night. I went over to Roses plac and from their to B Snare.
