over load hay plowed some in No 6 also  
started ridge across No 2 near bottom.

Frost last night turned out fine sunny day  
most Indian summer like we have had.

plowed across No 1 4 horses 1/2 in plow

down at night got his boots mended at W. Beth

65 paid R Ken furnace pipes \$1.80 Doug Wilson  
trimming trumps 20 cts got at Mennis on af  
shear landside and bolts for same 75 cts.
