- 23 Fine day sold two dozen eggs 2 1/2. to the miss. got 35 cts
- 24 gave Ben 10 cts for Church. gave 10. myself. got coal 20  
oil yesterday 13 cts 13
- 25 Roads are very bad. they have trouble in the schools since Roberton went off
- 30 We got home the buggy from the Shop fixing it cost 1.75  
Jim went to Lunenburg got his watch fixed 2.00  
took calf skin to Timmers, Murdy got his boots fixed, cost 45 cts. Jim do, 30
