Received from Rudd in full for turnips delivered 2 loads @ 38.00 Bought salmon at 75 cts, paid 30 in eggs Will got 2 saws sharpened at Uncle Jim's on Sat 25 cts	38 00 30	70 55 25
4	Sunday Frosty day snowing in A.M. cleared off fine sunny. Mr Mc Vicar home again preached in A.M. from Romans 6:23. and in evening from Jonah 3:1. sermon on second chances. in St Andrews church to united congregation. collection 15 cts We were all down at St Andrews at night.		15
5	Monday Cloudy day snowing at times windy we put up cow chop in A.M. also 90 lbs grain for Mrs Stone. after dinner I took them down to Eulins bought load manure from Steels put it on S.L. field half on fall wheat then went down for chop 45 cts also 40 cts for Nov 24.
