- 4 Went in afternoon with Mrs John Grant to visit at Burgess'. A storm came up suddenly about 5 P.M. and knocked down a number of trees in the village one of our butternuts broke off about 3 feet from the ground, and the old apple tree at what we call the garden gate broke broke half off. An old pine nigh the saw mill fell, an old pine up the river, at Burgess' had about 15 feet of its top broken off
- 5 Birdie went to L.L. today. Murdy finish mowing the hay, in forenoon got the beef on Monday 12.50
- 6 Did nothing of any consequence. Had a letter from Jimmie and sent him one Edward Tigeon worked with boys today Dyer put 3 loads in for us yesterday and today, sent \$10.00 to Auntie for value received. I was not at the women's meeting today
- 7 A few families went to Hamilton's island today Green's John Ais. Slacks & Mrs Grant. We finish putting in the hay
- 8 Birdie came home from Apple Hill & Jimmie & Bell came with her they all went to Lancaster Birdie was to see a drum maker
